The QBE eRiskHub provides tools and resources to help you understand your exposures, establish a response plan and minimize the effects of a breach on your organization.

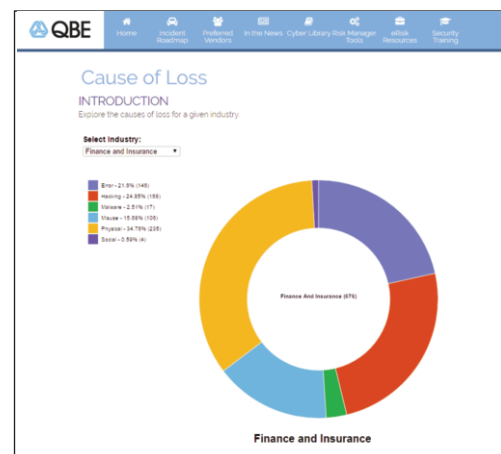
### Key Features of the eRiskHub

## New Tools

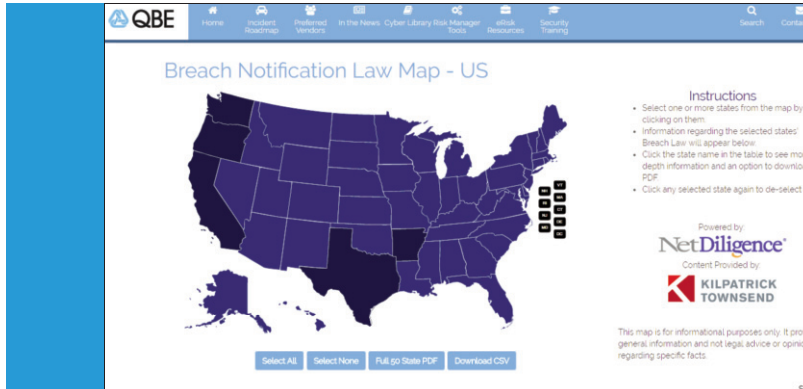
**Cause of Loss Tool:** The Cause of Loss tool helps your users understand the threats that are prevalent in their industry. We partnered with Verizon's Data Breach Investigation Report team to build this tool on a sample set of data from their investigations. Your users can click into an industry to see the leading causes of loss, then click into that cause to find a more detailed breakdown.

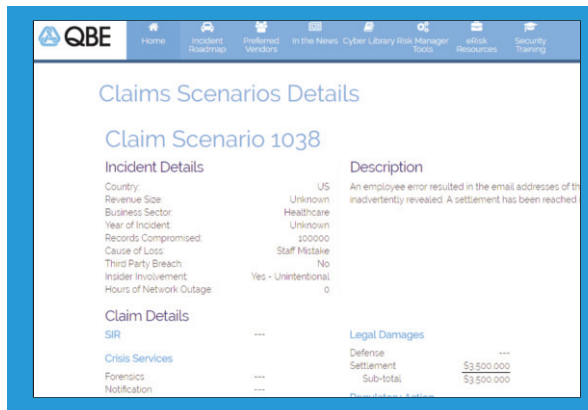
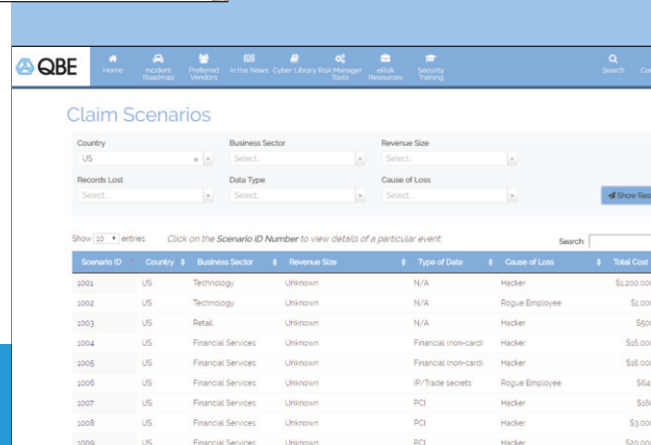
